6. Is child support included in the statutory amount awarded? \_\_\_\_\_ (attorney must confer personally with the assigned judge for exceptions)
7. Are there support arrearages? \_\_\_\_\_ Is a disposition for the arrearages included in the proposed pleadings? \_\_\_\_\_ (the pleadings must liquidate the arrearages in a reasonable manner)
